About the project:

Based on a story by Ray Bradbury, THE HALLOWEEN TREE follows the adventures of five friends who meet up to go trick-or-treating. Even though Joe Pipkin is too sick to join them, he asks his friends to meet him at The House, an old, deserted place in a ravine that none of them have ever dared to visit on Halloween night. What follows is an epic journey into the Undiscovered Country to find out the hidden secrets of Halloween and to save Joe Pipkin.

This is perfect opportunity to introduce students to the elements of theatre as a genre.

Project sequence:

Pre-show: Using the study guide provided by Geordie Productions, students will explore the various key elements used when creating a play based on a story, such as choosing which elements will make the most interesting story.

Play: Viewing of the play **The Halloween Tree**, on October 26, 2016 at 10 am, at the D.B. Clarke Theatre, 1455 boul. de Maisonneuve West, Montreal.

Post-show: Following the viewing of the play, are encouraged to pursue the exploration begun before the show using direct references to the performance.

Target audience: 10 elementary Cycle 2 classes - 2 classes from 5 schools
